2016 USS CANBERRA Reunion Information Portland, Maine 12-16 October 2016

Time is running out to sign up for our 2016 Reunion. The cutoff for all reservations is Monday, Sept. 12th.

The Hotel Contract and our Contract with Armed Forces Reunions both state that reservations must be in their hands by Monday, September 12th to be able to "guarantee" your spot.

After that date, hotel and tour reservations will only be accepted on a space available basis and hotel rates cannot be guaranteed.

As in the past, tour reservations may be limited to a first come first served basis. Please remember, we have a very liberal cancellation policy. So reserve early and cancel out at a later date if you find you cannot make the reunion.

For Reunion First Timers

It won't take you long to figure out that the place to be at the reunion is the USS Canberra Hospitality Room, located in the hotel's Evergreen Ballroom. Early October is usually a beautiful time in the

Portland area with temperatures averaging about 60 during the day and the near 40 at night. You may want to bring along a light/medium jacket.

The daily dress code is casual. It is also casual for all of our tours. Some of our tours require some walking. so bring a good pair of walking shoes.
