2023 Business Meeting Highlights

- * Ken Minick, President, opened the meeting, the Pledge of Allegiance was led by our Master-at-Arms, Gene Sibley. The Invocation followed and was given by Chaplain Bill Dorsey.
- * We were reminded to keep our ailing shipmates and families in our thoughts and prayers. Unfortunately, we had 4 Shipmates that had to cancel this year.
- * There were 6 First Timers in attendance this year. Although there were no WW2 Shipmates in attendance, we did have the son of the Shipmate (Jerry DerBoghosian) that started the USS Canberra Reunion Association back in 1964, Kenny DerBoghosian. We also had the son and grand daughter, Mike and Lexi Beach, of WW2 Shipmate Bob Beach in attendance. Bob and Mike have been printing our Newsletter since 2005.
- * The Divisions with the most attendees this year were OE and R Divisions with 5 each.
- * The first order of business was a talk about this year's 2023 reunion and why we didn't have one in 2022. This year's reunion was the smallest we have ever had. We had planned on a 2022 Reunion In Indianapolis, but AFR doesn't do Indianapolis. Our VP/Sec/Treas who lived there said he thought he could set it up. Unfortunately, Bob got sick, I tried to help. We also got Visit Indy to try and help. To say that the hotels in the area were not Military friendly would be an understatement. Some offered free Hospitality and Banquet rooms, but wanted to charge for drinks and snacks (\$5 beer, \$2 snack bags, etc...) others would let us bring in our own drinks and snacks, but would charge \$700-\$1,000 a day for the Hospitality and Banquet facilities. Therefore, we dropped Indianapolis from our reunion plans and by then it was too late to try for somewhere else.
- President Ken Minick then highlighted his time in setting up reunions. He started assisting Bryan Humphrey with setting up reunions in 2002 for the 2003 St Louis Reunion, Bryan was asked to do this as Paul McManuels was having health problems. Paul passed away just before the 2003 Reunion and Bryan took over running the Association. With Bryan in charge, he and Ken set the reunions up together through the 2006 reunion that was to be in Valley Forge. Unfortunately, Bryan was too sick to make the 2005 Reunion in San Antonio and he passed away shortly thereafter. Because of Bryan's sickness/death, Ken has been the lead in setting them up since then. He had great help, 1st with Ron Nullet and then with Bob Tylinski and more recently with Bill Baer's help. He stated that he would turn 85 this October, so he was giving up his position as President. He said he would be happy to assist a new President in any manner that he may want/need help. With Bob T's passing the Association will also need a new VP and a new Sec/ Treas. At the moment Jean Tylinski is filling the Sec/Treas position. The President asked if there were any members who would like to fill any of the officer positions in the Association. The President then stated that since there were no one wanting to take over at present, if we can't get a new leader the Association would have to either fold or try to join with another group.
- * New USS Canberra LCS-30 The LCS-30 was commissioned in Sydney Australia on 22 June 2023 The Commissioning was available for viewing over the internet.
- * The Association Composition/Database was commented on. As of 1 October 2023 we had 3,489 names in our database. Of those: 55 are Widows; 49 are Family Members; 9 are Honorary Members; 1 Staff (AFR) Member; 41 are Life Members and 150 are Yearly Paid Members. Which means we send out 305 Newsletters. We also have 2,410 Deceased; 729 Not Paid and 62 Missing (old addresses, cannot contact) in the database.
- * The Financial Report was submitted by our acting Sec/Treas Jean Tylinski. The Association is presently sound financially, although we still have many outstanding costs for the 2023 Reunion.
- * A special thanks was once again given to Bob's Printing (Mike Beach) for printing and mailing our Newsletters. Another special thanks was given to the ladies (Pat Johnson and Jean Tylinski) who keep the reunion registration running and to Bill Baer who takes great care of the hospitality room and also to all of the members that jump in and help us setup and break down the Hospitality Room.
- * A motion was made and seconded that the 2023 business meeting be closed.
