Description and Duties Vice President

The Vice-President shall perform such duties as specified by the President. He shall perform all the duties of the President during his absence or disability and shall exercise and perform such other powers and duties as may properly belong to his office or as may be assigned to him by the by-laws or the Board of Directors from time to time.

Secretary/Treasurer

The Secretary/Treasurer shall attend all meetings of the Association and the Directors and shall keep a true and complete record of the proceedings of such meetings in a book to be kept for this purpose.

The Secretary/Treasurer shall have custody of the records and papers of the Association and is responsible for the funds of the Association. The Secretary/Treasurer shall exercise and perform such other powers and duties as may properly belong to the office or as may be assigned to by the By-Laws or the Board of Directors from time to time.

The Secretary/Treasurer may be required by the Board of Directors to give bond for the faithful discharge of his duties in such sum and with such sureties as the Board of Directors may require. The President with the approval of the Board of Directors may appoint an Assistant Secretary/ Treasurer to serve under the Secretary/ Treasurer.

The Assistant Secretary/Treasurer may also be required to give bond for the faithful discharge of his duties in such sum and with such sureties as the Board of Directors may require.

Master at Arms

The Master-at-Arms shall be responsible for maintaining good order and decorum at all Association meetings.
